Because of the above mentioned errors, the balance mentioned in my account is not accurate. I want to make a payment next week and for that I want to know the exact balance in my account.

I request you to update all my details in my account at the earliest. I have been a customer of your bank for the past ten years and I hope you will value the complaints and suggestions of your customers.
