Some tips to write a sympathy thank you letter

- The letter must be hand written and not printed.
- The letter must convey a message of thanks for something specific whether it is a gift or service.
- The sender's expression in the letter must convey a feeling of gratitude. This he can do by wrapping up his thoughts and offering a general expression of appreciation.
- The letter must be concluded with warm gestures.
